WE High English Teacher Mr. Aaron Myerson entices all students to join his December 9th Enrichment Tutorial TODAY

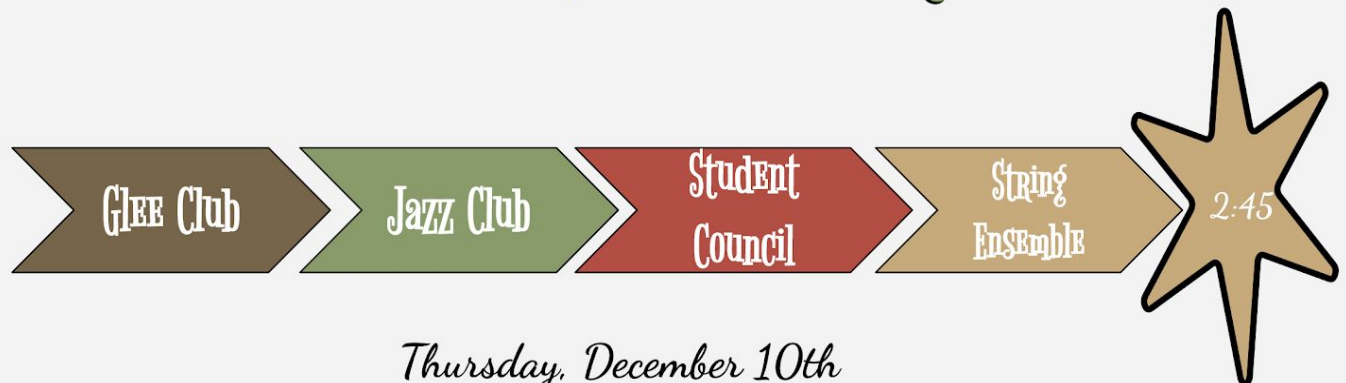
