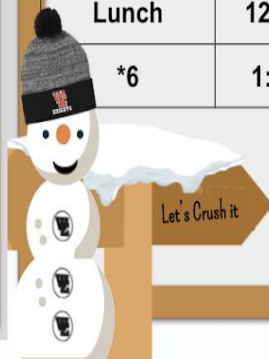

# WEMS Winter Cheerleading

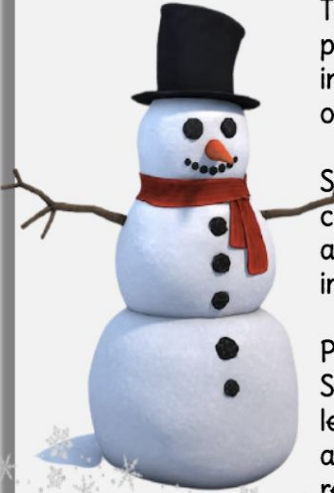
The Winter Cheerleading will be starting virtually **TODAY** during the extended lunch period. Today's meeting is an “interest only” to discuss the season.

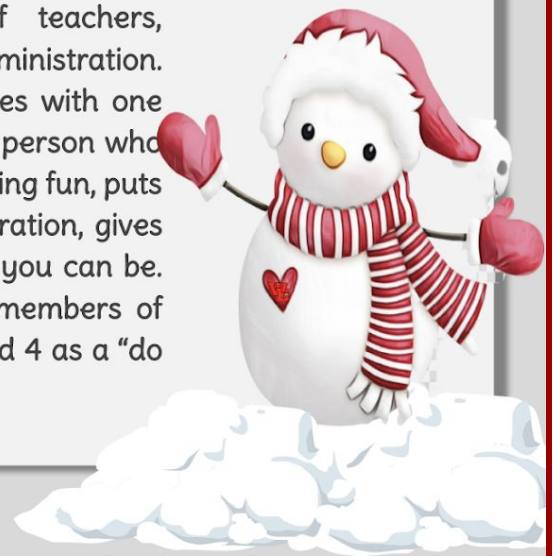

## Notes of Gratitude....Wednesday

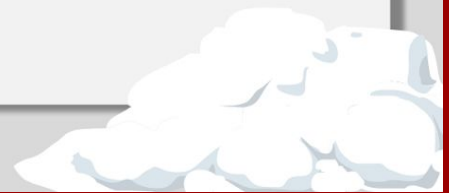

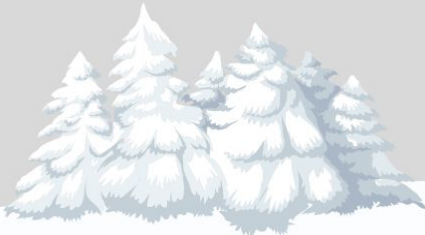
## HS Multicultural Club

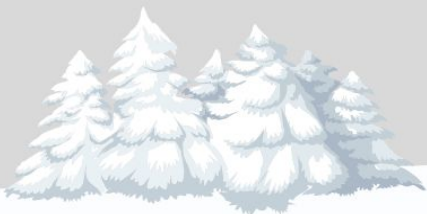
