# Grant Award Guidelines and Eligibility:

Grants will be awarded for initiatives that directly support WEFE's mission to assist "academic classroom needs." Those needs are defined as materials for instruction -- for grades 7-2 -- for which budgetary constraints prohibit the purchase of materials deemed useful and necessary to enhance such instruction. Grants may be awarded within a single unit or throughout an entire school year for a particular class, group of classes or department.

Professional development may qualify for a grant award if the knowledge gained can be directly transferred to students in the classroom, is essential to instruction, and is not otherwise funded by the school district.

Grants will only be awarded to West Essex Teachers. Teachers may apply as individuals, in groups or by department. The Foundation will not provide funding for the following: clubs, athletics, theatrical productions, or areas funded by the general budget, such as textbooks.
