



- . 2.95% LOCAL TAX LEVY INCREASE (GENERAL FUND)
- . TAX LEVY INCREASE OVER 2% DUE TO A HEALTH INSURANCE ADJUSTMENT OF \$220,039 AND USE OF BANKED CAP \$125,902
- . 2.64% OVERALL LEVY INCREASE- LOCAL TAX LEVY + DEBT SERVICE
- . \$1,553,271 IN STATE AID- II.61% INCREASE FROM LAST YEAR
- . \$1,081,195 EXPENDITURE INCREASE
